

## COMBINATION LOCK INSTRUCTIONS

## To set your personal combination:

- 1. Dial 0-0-0-0 on the indication line, then pull up the shackle.
- 2. Turn the shackle 180°, then press the shackle down and set the 4-point combination lock to your private code, turning each dial until the desired digits are on the indication line.
- 3. Pull up the shackle and return to the original position.
- 4. Your new private code is now set.

**Always remember your code** and keep it in a secure place from others. To change your code, follow steps 1-4, using your new private code at step 1.

## **Cleaning:**

Over time, dust, particles and chemicals in the air can create friction inside the locks' components hindering the performance of the lock.

We recommended cleaning and lubrication every 3-6 months to keep your lock operating like new. If you are using your lock outdoors, or in a dusty/corrosive environment, you should follow this process every 3 months.

- 1. To clean the lock, use pressurized air to blow all dust out of the dial and shackle openings.
- 2. Lubricate your lock using an all-purpose oil or lubrication spray, but **AVOID** using dry graphite, or a silicone lubricant as these can cause damage to your lock.
- 3. Apply lubricant sparingly. All you will need is a very light spray(aerosol), or a few drops(oil). Lubricate both the dials and the shackle.
- 4. Allow lubricant to drain into the lock. You can tap the lock on a table to help distribute the lubricant inside the lock.
- 5. After application, turn the dials and open and close the lock several times to distribute the lubricant. Wipe excess lubricant off the lock, shackle and dials using a microfiber cloth and let the lock air dry. Once dry, it's ready to use again.
