

PADLOCK INSTRUCTIONS

To use:

- 1. Insert key, then pull up the shackle.
- 2. To lock, press the shackle back down into the body of the lock.

Always keep your keys in a safe place away from others.

Cleaning:

Over time, dust, particles and chemicals in the air can create friction inside the locks' components hindering the performance of the lock.

We recommended cleaning and lubrication every 3-6 months to keep your lock operating like new. If you are using your lock outdoors, or in a dusty/corrosive environment, you should follow this process every 3 months.

- 1. To clean the lock, use pressurized air to blow all dust out of the keyway and shackle openings.
- 2. Lubricate your lock using an all-purpose oil or lubrication spray, but **AVOID** using dry graphite, or a silicone lubricant as these can cause damage to your lock.
- 3. Apply lubricant sparingly. All you will need is a very light spray(aerosol), or a few drops(oil). Lubricate both the keyway and the shackle.
- 4. Allow lubricant to drain into the lock. You can tap the lock on a table to help distribute the lubricant inside the lock.
- 5. After application, insert the key and open and close the lock several times to distribute the lubricant. Wipe excess lubricant off the lock, shackle and key using a microfiber cloth and let the lock air dry. Once dry, it's ready to use again.
